





2019: 1070 2020: 856

How many bills enacted into law?

2019: 383 2020: 151

How many education-related generally?

2019: 28 general 2020: 6 general

2019: 11 local 2020: 7 local

FY21 EDUCATION BUDGET



Act 20-169 \$7.2 billion ETF budget

- Lower than pre-pandemic numbers (\$7.5 billion)
- No 3% pay raise (seemed "given")

\$1.25 BILLION EDUCATION BOND ISSUE

Act 2020-167

- Last bond issue was \$1 billion in 2007
- K-12 portion: \$912 million
 - •\$400,00 each system
 - •\$426 million per ADM
 - •\$426 million by PSF for FY19



- Higher ed: \$217.8 million
- Community Colleges: \$120 million

Reduces ETF receipts by \$79.8 million annually for 20 years

FY20 ADVANCEMENT & TECH FUND

Education Advancement & Technology Fund

Of \$512 million available, released half \$178 M K-12 -- FY20 supplemental

6 authorized uses, by statute

\$15 million off the top to be used as 1st year repayment for bond issue

Act 20-154



LOCAL OCCUPATIONAL TAX AUTHORITY

Act 2020-14

Prohibits a municipality from imposing an occupational tax IF not already in effect by February 1, 2020

Only way to authorize a new occupational tax will be by local legislation

UNWORKABLE OPEN RECORDS ACT REVISION

- Removes reasonable standard for compliance 5-day deadline, limited exceptions
- Removes requirement for requests in writing oral requests authorized
- Removes reasonable penalties
 \$75/day penalty from date
 should have released records



CYBERSECURITY IN SUPPLEMENTAL

Alabama Supercomputer Authority\$2.5 million for K-12 cybersecurity and IT support

Earmarks \$1 million shall be spent to provide specified professional development for all education employees on digital security




