





Critical Business Issues - Talladega




Talladega City School District was faced with:

- Time consuming distribution of credit cards
- Verifying statements
- Tons of checks from teacher to district (return tax)
- District card management
 - Lost card/reissue
 - Verify charges against receipts
 - Cards flagged for fraud
- 3 days per month district reconciliation
- Manual receipt collection
 - Lost receipt verifications



Critical Business Issues - Tuscumbia



Tuscumbia City School District was faced with:

- Time consuming small purchase orders
 - Disproportionate amount of labor and time to transaction size
- Reconciling packing slips against invoices
- Manual data entry
- Bookkeepers manually tracking teacher's balances
- District card management


Critical Business Issues - Across Alabama

District	Old Process	Critical Business Issue
Baldwin County	P cards Collecting receipts	Labor intensive to trackTime consuming card distribution
Brewton City	PO process	Approval process logjamTime consuming for small transactions
Birmingham City	PO process	 Painful for teachers - only 66% of teachers were spending their CIS funds Approval logjams






