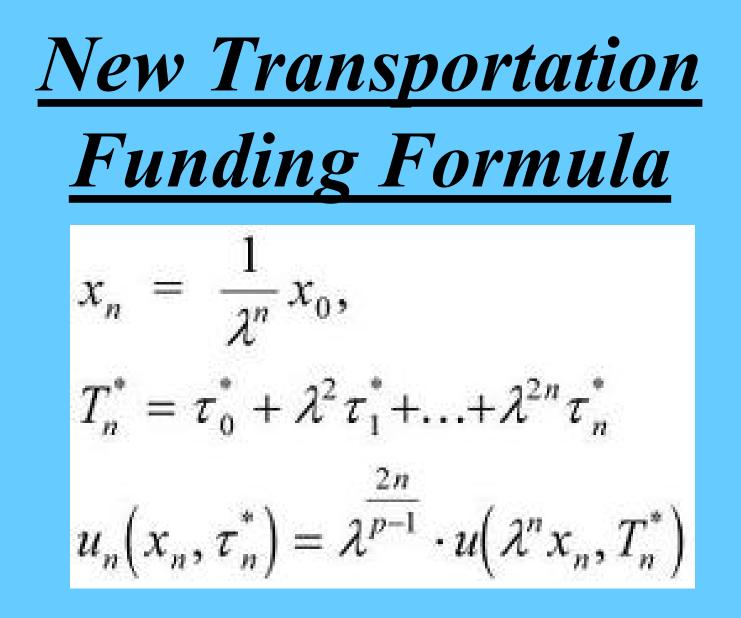

Qualifying Buses

- Morning and Afternoon Route Buses
- Midday Route Buses
- 20% Spare Allowance
 - Lift Equipped Buses



- Non-Lift Equipped Buses

SALARIED POSITIONS

- Positions earned based on size of operation
- # of Bus Drivers based on efficient routing
- Salary amounts from LEAPS
 - Amounts determined by individual system salary schedule
 - Maximum salary applied
 - Minimums for unfilled positions
- % of positions earned for small operations
- Function and object code usage will be limited
- Flexibility with positions
- Applies to Contract Systems

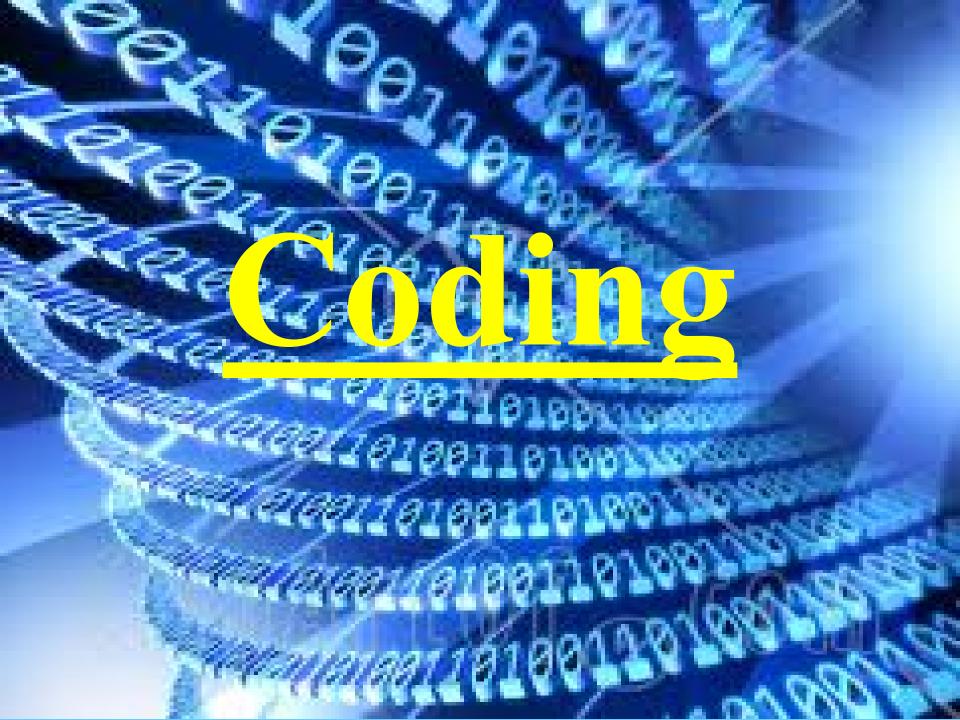

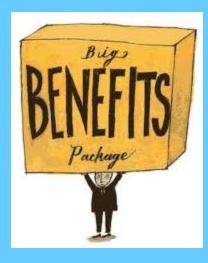

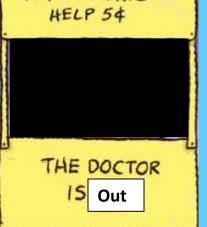
