 - Troubleshooting network equipment, performance and firewalls
 - Troubleshooting computer hardware and software

Other requirements for this position include the following:

- Demonstrate ability to develop, manage, and coordinate network operations in a Windows OS environment
- Experience with VOIP technology
- Experience managing DNS
- CCNA and/or Adtran certification must be obtained within the first thirty (30) months of employment and current status must be maintained
- Some overnight travel will be required
- A sign language proficiency level of SURVIVAL according to the AIDB evaluation system must be obtained within the first thirty (30) months of employment

- Design and document network operations and report on network status

- Plan, coordinate, and manage various network hardware and server replacements as needed

- Implement and maintain content filtering for AIDB networks
- Work as a team member with IT Staff providing on-call technical assistance and troubleshooting as required
